

# Barneys Barrel 2026 NOR, SI's & Entry Form

## 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2026

### Eligibility and Entry

This race is open to all Keelers, and Trailer Yachts.

Entry is free.

### Course

- Start Kissing Point clubrooms,
- Leave Ross Beacon to starboard,
- Leave S7 to port,
- Leave red pole beacon inside The Nook to port,
- finish between yellow 5 knot buoy SE of Parua Bay clubhouse and Parua Bay Club Jetty leaving yellow 5 knot buoy to starboard ie finish heading in an easterly direction.

No course sheets will be provided. If required, save the NOR and Course sheets to your phone for offline access.

### Start

Start time is 1100.

The race will start outside the Kissing Point clubrooms.

At the start gun, a selected crew member will be required to drink an entire can of soft drink (supplied). Once the drink is completed they will run to their boat which will be on the KP dock with their crew waiting.

Alternatively, if the boat normally lives on the Kissing Point poles, this boat will be able to start from the poles. The crew member at the start must do the above start then row out to the moored boat. Motors may be used up until the white triangle cable markers (approx. 300 metres from KP clubrooms) are passed.

### Finish

Finish between yellow 5 knot buoy SE of Parua Bay clubhouse and Parua Bay Club Jetty leaving yellow 5 knot buoy to starboard ie finish heading in an easterly direction. Once finished, clear the finish line and avoid the mooring field when under sail. The PB club jetty is not available for keelers post race in order to allow trailer yachts to access

the ramp for haul out. Keelers will have to anchor out after finishing, but please ensure that you are clear of the finish line(unless you are last!). A rib will be available for any keeler crew that need transport ashore for the prizegiving. Call on CH77 to be collected.

## Retirement

If you will be retiring from the race text your boat name and reason for retiring to Don on 027 223 9830. If you require assistance within Parua Bay call "Barneys Barrel RIB" on VHF CH77.

## Prize Giving

Prize giving will be held at the Parua Bay club rooms after everyone has finished. Some BBQ food will be available at Parua Bay post race thanks to the generosity of UK Sails. BYO drinks/ salads/snacks. This is a fun family event and we encourage everyone to come into the club rooms and attend prize giving.

## Safety

The organizers strongly recommend the wearing of lifejackets at all times for boats of all sizes. The consumption of alcohol is discouraged while competing in this event.

## Postponment

If the weather is unsuitable on the 21<sup>st</sup> February the event may be rescheduled. The revised date will be advised at Kissing Point on the 21<sup>st</sup>, or by email.
